UT SELECT TIER

The new UT SELECT Tier benefit is available to UT SELECT participants receiving services from certain UT physicians and certain UT medical facilities. Pay reduced copays, reduced coinsurance and \$0/day hospital copay when seeing a UT physician at a UT owned facility. You can also save on physician charges when treatment is received from a UT physician at a non UT owned hospital. See below to identify if the facility is UT owned.*

Here are three examples of how benefits will apply for the new UT SELECT Tier:

- Example 1: Office visit (either UT owned or non UT owned hospital)—Member pays office visit copay of \$20 or \$25 when performed by a UT physician.
- Example 2: Services requiring deductible / coinsurance with a UT physician at a UT owned facility—Member pays regular \$350 deductible, 10% coinsurance on physician and facility charges, and \$0 hospital copay / day at UT owned medical facility.
- Example 3: Services requiring deductible / coinsurance with a UT physician at a non UT owned facility—Member pays regular \$350 deductible and 10% coinsurance on physician charges, 20% coinsurance for facility charges, and \$100 hospital copay / day.

- UT Medical Branch Galveston
- UT Health Northeast (Tyler)

UT Health Houston, UT Health San Antonio and UT Austin Dell Medical School do not own their own hospitals, but the UT SELECT Tier benefit is available for their physician services and UT owned clinics.

The UT Tier is not available when receiving services from UT Southwestern and MD Anderson Cancer Center physicians and facilities. Regular UT SELECT benefits continue to apply.
